Know Before You Go

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Overview:

Hosted by the Secretary's Teacher Advisory, the New Mexico Teacher Leader Network, and the NM Public Education Department, the 2018 New Mexico Teacher Summit will bring together over 1300 teachers from across the state to learn, collaborate, and celebrate with their peers.

Attendees will enjoy inspiring keynote speakers while also gaining access to useful information through breakout sessions. The sessions will be focused on providing teachers with new information and opportunities to enhance their classroom practice and improve student outcomes. The program will also allow for ample time to network with colleagues, as well as, at the end of day 1, enjoy a celebratory dinner. This is going to be an unforgettable event!

Location and Parking:

The 2018 NM Teacher Summit will take place at the [Albuquerque Convention Center](#) West on 401 2nd St NW, Albuquerque, NM 87102.

Parking will be provided for ALL attendees. If the NMPED has provided your lodging for the night of June 18th, you will receive complimentary parking at your hotel. If you are driving in locally each day, you will have the option when you register to indicate that you need a parking pass. The parking pass will print directly on your registration ticket; you will need to print the pass to park.

Costs:

The NMPED pays for:

- conference
- lodging night of June 18th, as applicable
- parking
- lunch and dinner day 1
- lunch day 2
- quality professional development and keynote speakers

Teachers pay for:

- mileage
- any other meals, snacks, and beverages required

Lodging:

If you live 50 miles or more from Albuquerque, the NMPED will pay lodging and tax for the night of Monday June 18th at either The Doubletree or Hyatt Hotel. You will need to reserve your room using the links on the Teacher Summit Registration site or calling the hotel directly and asking for the Teacher Summit Group Rate. To reserve and hold your room, the hotel will require a personal credit card; however, your lodging cost will be directly billed to NMPED and you will only be responsible for incidentals, if you incur any. You will manage your reservation directly with the hotel if you need to cancel or modify your stay. Please note, if you are unable to attend the Teacher Summit, you must cancel your room directly with the hotel by Monday June 11th or your credit card will be charged for one night's stay.

Weather:

The event is being held in the summer in Albuquerque; it will be hot. Please plan accordingly, but note that the Convention Center keeps the air conditioning on at a very cool temperature. It is advised that you bring a sweater or light jacket if you get cold. The temperature is not able to be adjusted during the event.

Additional Food and Beverage Needs:

The Albuquerque Convention Center is ADA compliant. The Convention Center provides service ramps to entrances, an array of passenger elevators, restroom facilities for the disabled, brailled instructions and directions at strategic locations throughout the building, and access to phones at each level of the facility with (TDD) hearing-impaired functions.

When you arrive at the event each day, please head directly to Convention Center West directly in front of Ballrooms A, B, and C to sign in. This will ensure that your attendance is accurately recorded and that you receive your certificate of participation.
